

Fact: A lion's roar can be heard from 5 miles away.

Other information: A lion opens its mouth about 7 inches. There are 5,280 ft in one mile and 12 inches in a foot.



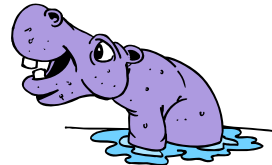
Fact: A blue whale can make sound at 188 dB (louder than a rock concert) which can be heard 530 miles away.

Other information: A blue whale is 85 feet long. A mile is 5,280 ft.



Fact: A hippo eats 100 lbs of grass in a single night.

Other information: A hippo weighs 5,000 lbs.



Fact: A polar bear travels 30 km a day.

Other information: A polar bear weighs 400 kg. Each mile gets multiplied by 1.6 to get km. There are 2.2 kg per 1 pound.



Fact: Dogs can smell a scent from $\frac{1}{2}$ mile away.

Other information: The average size nose of a dog from start to tip is .75 inches. One mile is 5,280 ft.



Fact: Snow leopards jump 45 feet.

Other information: Snow leopards are about 42 inches long.
